## GRAY SAINT-SEBASTIEN

The Village of Saint- Sebastien has more than 150 years of existence. Located in the Eastern Townships, Quebec, its territory is found near Le Morne. Le Morne is a mountainous granite massif dating back 350 million years.

Saint- Sebastien became the Canadian capital of Granit. At the end of the 1920s, the stone of this Quarry and that of the Silver Granite quarry became famous by being chosen to decorate, among others, the exterior walls of the Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Basilica and the Saint Joseph's Oratory in Montreal. Nowadays, only one quarry is in operation and the Gris Saint-Sebastien variety is extracted.

The inspiration of the Granit of Saint- Sebastien allowed us to create this new Gray Natural color. Paler than these sister colors Westmont and Fermont, the color Saint-Sebastien is closer to a creamy white and more neutral.
